The 2015 Chilean Mission Reunion (1956 to 1975) will be held Friday, April 3, 2015 at the Pheasant Pointe Utah Stake Center located at 857 West 3200 North, Lehi, UT 84043, from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM. **Please note the change of location and time from last year.** **Directions:** From I-15, take exit # 284 / UT – 92 / Timpanogos Highway east bound; travel approximately 1.6 miles; turn right (south) at the stoplight at 1200 West and travel .3 mile; turn left (east) on 3200 North and travel .3 mile; the chapel is on the right. We suggest that you park on the east side of the chapel, enter through the east entrance and proceed to the cultural hall.

There will not be a program at this year's event. There will be plenty of time for visiting with friends, members and former companions. **Refreshments:** Soft drinks, water, ice, cups, condiments and paper supplies will be provided. Please bring finger / snack foods: meat trays and bread, rolls, veggie trays, empanadas, cookies, chips, dip, etc. If you would like to bring empanadas, please call or email us for information about local Chilean restaurants. **Other:** Appropriate attire is "dressy casual."

El Reencuentro Anual de Misioneros Retornados de la Misión Chilena y amigos de la misión, 1956 a 1975, se llevará a cabo el viernes, 3 de abril de 2015 en Lehi, Utah, EE UU. El evento se realizará en el centro de estaca Pheasant Pointe, ubicado en 857 West 3200 North, Lehi, UT desde las 16:00 horas hasta las 20:00 horas.

Favor de estacionar al lado este de la capilla y entrar por la entrada oriente de la capilla y proceder al salón cultural.
