Dear alumni and friends of the Chilean Mission.

We are pleased to inform you that arrangements have been finalized to broadcast via the Church's satellite system to selected stake centers in the United States the two major events of the 50th Anniversary Celebration of the Chilean Mission.

The Devotional celebrating the 50th Anniversary of the establishment of the Chilean Mission will be broadcast Saturday, October 8, 2011 at 2:00 PM MDT, 1:00 PM PDT to certain stake centers in AZ, UT and WA. It is anticipated that the Devotional will last 1½ to 2 hours.

The Cultural Celebration will be broadcast on Saturday, October 15, 2011 at 4:00 PM MDT, 3:00 PM PDT to the same stake centers in UT, AZ, and WA. This program will consist of a brief Devotional, followed by a short break, and the Cultural Event which will begin about approximately 5:00 PM MDT, 4:00 PM PDT.
