Second, we have attached sample airfares for eight major markets in the U. S. (SLC, LAX, PHX, BOS, SEA, JFK, DFW and MIA). Scroll down through the document to see the fares. Keep in mind that the lower priced fares typically start to go up significantly if not purchased two weeks or more in advance.
